**Second baseman Rod Carew won his fifth American League batting crown with a .359 average. He was the team's only member of the All Star team. He was second on the ball club with 14 home runs and led the Twins in hits (192), RBI (80), doubles (24), and runs scored (89). Dan Ford's fifteen taters led the team. He knocked in 59 runs. Eric Soderholm, Steve Braun, and Larry Hisle all hit eleven homers. Designated hitter Tony Oliva, hobbled with bad legs, contributed 13 home runs and 58 RBI. The Twins' .271 batting average put them in second place in the A.L. They finished eighth in home runs (121)... Jim Hughes topped the pitching staff with 16 victories while Bert Blyleven added 15 and Dave Goltz spun fourteen. Blyleven topped the staff with 233 strikeouts, 20 complete games, and three shutouts. The staff ERA of 4.05 was tenth in the A.L. They were second in strikeouts (846)...Just over 700,000 fans showed up to watch the Twins at Metropolitan Stadium, last in the American League for attendance. A crowd of about 14,805 were in the ball park for "Harmon Killebrew Day" May 4<sup>th</sup>. Killebrew, now with Kansas City, hit a home run in his first at bat against his former ball club.**
