Outfielder/first baseman Reggie Smith (19 homers, 76 RBI) and catcher Ted Simmons (18 home runs, 100 RBI) led the ball club at the plate. The Redbirds were National League leaders with a .273 batting average and 1,572 base hits. They hit a paltry 81 home runs and swiped 116 bases--the latter good for fifth in the league...Lynn McGlothen (nine complete games, 146 K's) and Bob Forsch each won 15 games to lead the starting staff. Forsch struck out 108 batters...The hurlers turned in a 3.57 ERA...Bob Gibson (3-10, 60 strikeouts) wrapped up a Hall of Fame career at the end of the season...Third baseman Ken Reitz won a Gold Glove as the N.L.'s top fielder at the "hot corner". The Cards were 8-11 in the season series with the first place, Pirates, and ended the season in a tie with Mets, 10 ½ games behind Pittsburgh's "Lumber Company".
