Mike Jorgensen's 18 dingers led an Expos ball club that hit .244 and 98 home runs for the season. Catcher Gary Carter followed with 17 homers and a team high 68 runs batted in. Jorgensen knocked in sixty-seven. Pete Mackanin, acquired in a trade with Texas for Willie Davis, popped 12 home runs while Larry Parrish added 10 round-trippers and 65 RBI while leading the team in base hits (146). "Pepe" Mangual was the team leader with 84 runs scored... Number One starter Steve Rogers confirmed himself as the leader of the pitching corps with 11 wins, 137 strikeouts, and 12 complete games. Reliever Dale Murray topped the staff with 15 wins out of the bullpen. Lefty "Woodie" Fryman won nine ball games, completed seven, and tied Rogers for the lead in shutouts (three). Spot starter Dan Warthen was a winner of eight contests and struck out 128 batters. Starter Dennis Blair had eight victories as well. The staff ended the season seventh in the N.L. with a 3.72 ERA.
