**Bobby Bonds led the Yanks with 32 homers and 93 runs scored. Thurman Munson popped 12 dingers and posted a team high 102 runs batted in as well as 190 base hits. Graig Nettles finished second on the ball club with 21 home runs and 91 RBI. Roy White hit 12 round-trippers and drove in fifty-nine. The Yankees ended the year third in the A. L. in batting (.264) and tenth in home runs (110)... "Catfish" Hunter led the pitching staff with a 23-14 record, 177 strikeouts, 30 complete games, and seven shutouts. "Doc" Medich finished the season with a 16-16 record. Rudy May won 14 games while Pat Dobson posted 11 wins. Yankee pitchers combined for a 3.29 ERA ranking them third in the league... They tied the Orioles for the most complete games in the major leagues (70)... The Yanks finished 12 games behind the division winning, Red Sox, who won the season series from New York, 11-5.**

Elliott Maddox badly injured one of his knees after accidentally slipping on wet grass in left center field at Shea Stadium. A very solid outfielder who could effortlessly run down fly balls and possessed a strong throwing arm, he was really never the same player again... Billy Martin--in his first of FIVE tours as Yankee manager--replaced Bill Virdon, August 1<sup>st</sup>. Managers' records: Virdon (53-51), Martin (30-26).

(From 1974 through 1975 the Yankees were tenants of the Mets at Shea Stadium as "The Big Ballyard in the South Bronx," the original Yankee Stadium [The House That Ruth Built], underwent renovations. "The Stadium" had been closed after the last out of the 1973 season.)
