The White Sox organization and fans, all who had high hopes for the 2019 campaign and a play-off spot, experienced a season in the doldrums by being an also-ran. The ballclub settled into third place of the AL Central, June 4<sup>th</sup>, and were 12 ½ games out of first at the All Star break. They would play out the schedule at 30-45 to finish 28 ½ games in back of division champion Minnesota and 20 games behind second place Cleveland...All Star and native Cuban Jose Abreu produced a terrific season with a team-leading 33 homers, 123 RBI, 180 base hits, and 38 doubles. Rookie Eloy Jimenez followed with 31 jacks while Yoan Moncada enjoyed a solid campaign in the field at a new position while clubbing 25 home runs and driving home 79. Jimenez had 79 RBI as well. Leury Garcia scored the most runs (93). Shortstop Tim Anderson, consistent all season-long, won the American League batting title. The Sox hit .261, good for fifth in the A. L., and 182 homers (13<sup>th</sup>)...Starter Lucas Giolito, 24, took his place as the ace of the pitching staff with a 14-9 W/L record and 228 strikeouts, the best numbers of the group. Thirty-four-year-old Ivan Nova won 11 ballgames; Reynaldo Lopez, 25, won ten. Youngster Dylan Cease, 23, impressed with 81 K's and four victories. The staff ERA (4.90) placed them ninth.
