Following a 15-12 April, the Cubbies finally got rolling being tied or holding first place alone in the NL Central when they spent 23 days in the top spot May 7-31, and again for brief runs at the end of June, mid-July, and the early part of August. A nine-game losing skein from September 17th through the 26th relegated them to a final third place finish and out of the post-season. Many believed the Cubs were ready for a big push to possibly the World Series, but the result was skipper Joe Maddon being fired the second-to-last day of the season. The front office had decided a "new voice" was needed from a new field manager...Team Leaders: Kyle Schwarber (38 home runs); Anthony Rizzo (94 RBI); Kris Bryant (153 base hits, 108 runs scored)...Jon Lester (165 K's) and Jose Quintana both won thirteen games to pace the pitching staff. Yu Darvish (only 6-8 W/L) topped the group with 229 strikeouts. Kyle Hendricks won eleven ballgames. The staff ERA (4.10) was third best in the league...As a team, the Cubs hit .252 (7th) and 256 home runs, second most in the senior circuit.
