Reds legacy David Bell (son of Buddy) came on-board as manager after four consecutive dreadful seasons with 90-plus losses, a total of 381. The Reds hit .247 as a team (12th in the N. L.) and 227 homers (7th). Eugenio Suarez blasted 49 of those, drove in 103 runs, stroked 156 base hits, and scored 87 runs to lead the ballclub. His home run total was second-highest in the big leagues. Yasiel Puig had 22 jacks before his trade to Cleveland. Rookie Nick Senzel showed a lot of future promise after hitting 12 home runs and driving home 42. In just 56 games, Aristides Aquino, 25, launched 19 homers and collected 47 RBI. Luis Castillo's 15 wins and 226 strikeouts were the most on the pitching staff. Sonny Gray turned in a solid season with eleven victories and lowest ERA among the starters. The remarkably versatile Michael Lorenzen was consistently steady while working from the bullpen and played 29 flawless games in the outfield. The staff's ERA for the year was 4.18 (4th).
