Steve Carlton won the Cy Young Award: 27-10 record with 310 K's and 30 complete games. He was the winning pitcher in about 46 percent of the Phils' victories. "Lefty" also led the National League with a 1.97 ERA, innings pitched, and game starts. Reliever Darrell Brandon followed Carlton with a meager seven wins...Mike Schmidt made his debut, September 12th, against the Mets. His first big league homer was off the Expos' Balor Moore, in Philly, September 16th...Twenty-one year old Greg Luzinski led the Phils with 18 home runs, 68 RBI, and 158 base hits. Don Money hit 15 homers. Larry Bowa had a team high 67 runs scored. The Phillies hit .236 and 98 home runs for the season...The pitching staff posted a 3.66 ERA ranking them eighth in the league...Carlton finished fifth in N.L. MVP voting...Long time GM John Quinn was fired June 3rd and replaced by farm director Paul Owens. "The Pope" assumed managerial duties, as well, July 10th, when Frank Lucchesi was let go after a disastrous 26-50 start...The Phillies won ONE season series, 8-7, from the Cards. They split three other series with the Braves, Padres, and Giants.
