This is a Phillies ball club which finished last--a whopping 46 games behind National League champion, Cincinnati...From July 29th through the first game of a twin-bill August 20th, the Phils LOST 23 straight games. The record-setting streak for futility was snapped in the second game of that doubleheader at Milwaukee when Philadelphia beat the Braves, 7-4, to make their ledger 31-87...Don Demeter led the ball club with 20 homers and 68 RBI. Centerfielder Tony Gonzalez hit 12 dingers and knocked in fifty-eight while first sacker Pancho Herrera popped 13 home runs and drove home fifty-one. Not surprisingly, the Phillies were LAST in the N.L. with a .243 batting average and seventh after hitting 103 homers...Art Mahaffey was the pitching staff's leader with eleven wins, 158 K's, 12 complete games, and three shutouts. John Buzhardt and Chris Short followed with SIX victories each. The staff ERA was 4.61 (LAST) and fifth in strikeouts (775)...Popular reserve catcher "Choo Choo" Coleman's real name is Clarence...The Phillies somehow won THREE of twenty-two games against the pennant-winning Redlegs.
