****Team leaders: Don Mincher (25 homers, 78 RBI); Gene Brabender (13 wins, 139 K's). Reliever Diego Segui won 12 games. The expansion and critically under-financed Pilots hit .234 with a staff ERA of 4.35. Their only season in Seattle drew just under 678,000 to dilapidated Sicks Stadium. This horrible ball club was the subject of Jim Bouton's book Ball Four--his diary of his very odd season--featuring "The Manager Who Wasn't", Joe Schultz. "Let's go get 'em and then pound some Budweiser," Schultz, a former catcher and Cardinals coach, was fond of saying to motivate his non-descript junk heap. The Pilots bailed out and moved to Milwaukee for the 1970 season.****
