Only three seasons removed from a World Championship, the Royals lost at least 100 games for the first time since 2006. By the end of April, K. C. was already in the cellar with a 7-21 record, 8 ½ games out of first place in the AL Central. When they reached Game 81, they sat 19 ½ games out at 25-56...The Royals had already lost a big bat when Lorenzo Cain left as a free-agent to sign with Milwaukee. All Star catcher Salvador Perez led the team with 27 home runs and 80 RBI despite playing in only 129 games. He missed the start of the season after suffering a knee injury while moving into a new home. Whit Merrifield made the offense go with his major league high 192 base hits and 45 stolen bases. His 88 runs scored and 43 doubles topped the ball club. Before an in-season trade to the Brewers, Mike Moustakas socked 20 homers. As a team, K. C. hit .245 and 155 home runs...Nine wins led the pitching staff from both starter Jakob Junis and spot-starter Brad Keller. Junis paced the hurlers with 164 strikeouts. Danny Duffy (8-12 W/L record) whiffed 141 batters. The pitching corps ended the year fourteenth in the league in ERA (4.94) and saves (33).
