The revitalized Mets opened the campaign making their rookie manager look good with a 9-1 start out of the blocks. The ball club was in first place at the end of April. The year began to turn sour in May after injuries to key players kept them out of the line-up for extended periods of time. June was a disaster as the Mets went 5-21. On July 31st at Washington, they were demolished in their worst loss ever, 25-4...New York hit .234 for the season--14th in the N.L. They knocked out 170 homers. Michael Conforto was the leader in home runs (28), RBI (82), and runs scored (78). Amed Rosario had the most base hits (142)...Ace Jacob deGrom had a season for the ages: the lowest ERA in the majors and the most strikeouts on the pitching staff (269). He won ten ball games while finishing fourth in the majors in punch outs. Noah Syndergaard (155 K's) was 13-4 in wins/losses; a resurgent Zack Wheeler was a flashy 12-7 with 179 strikeouts. The staff ERA was tenth in the league (4.07).
