For the first time since 2011, the D-Backs were a playoff team. When both the Brewers and Cardinals LOST their ballgames, September 24th, coupled with an Arizona walk-off WIN over Miami, the D-Backs earned "home field" advantage for the N.L. Wild Card game where they knocked off Colorado. The Dodgers eliminated Arizona from the post-season in the NLDS after a three-game sweep...J. D. Martinez, acquired in a trade with Detroit, July 18th, was the catalyst the D-Backs needed to put them over the top. He added a lot of fire-power to the offense which complimented their great pitching. Martinez clouted 29 homers in 62 games, including FOUR in one game, September 4th versus the Dodgers. Paul Goldschmidt led the ball club with 36 home runs, 120 RBI, 166 base hits, and 117 runs scored. As a team, the D-Backs hit .254 and 220 homers, the latter fifth in the league...Arizona pitching was led by Zack Greinke's 17 wins. He struck out 215 batters. Lefty Robbie Ray whiffed 218 opponents and was 15-5 for the year. Fellow southpaw Patrick Corbin won fourteen and totaled 178 K's. The staff was second in the N.L. in ERA (3.66) and strikeouts (1,482)...The Diamondbacks scored 812 runs for the season while the pitching staff allowed only 659 base runners to cross home plate, the latter second fewest in the league.
