The Cards ended the year fifth in the N.L. in hitting (.256) and eighth in home runs (196). After being called up from Triple, Paul DeJong was inserted at second base but would spend most of the season at shortstop and led the team with 25 homers. Yadi Molina (18 dingers) topped the ball club with 82 RBI and 137 base hits despite being placed on "concussion protocol" late in the schedule after taking a foul ball off his catcher's mask. Matt Carpenter and Tommy Pham both slugged 23 home runs with the latter collecting a team high 95 runs scored. Pham was second with 73 RBI...The pitching staff finished sixth in the league with a 4.01 ERA. The Redbirds boasted THREE twelve-game winners: Carlos Martinez, Michael Wacha, and Adam Wainwright. Martinez and his 217 strikeouts were the most on the staff; Wacha followed with 158 punch outs. The staff's THREE complete games led the league. Martinez had two of them...St. Louis failed to make the post-season for the second straight year but only four games from a Wild Card berth...Constant turnover of personnel due to injuries or ineffectiveness held back the Cards all season long from developing any positive consistency.
