Charlie Blackmon compiled a "career season" after leading the National League in batting average, base hits (213), runs scored (137), and triples (14). He added 37 homers, 35 doubles, and 104 RBI. He tied Nolan Arenado for the team high in homers (37) and finished fifth in league MVP voting. Arenado topped the N.L. with 43 doubles, won his fifth career Gold Glove, scored 100 runs, and led the Rockies in RBI (130). He was FOURTH in MVP tallies. Mark Reynolds popped 30 dingers and drove in 97 runs. Colorado led the N.L. in hitting (.273) and ended the year tenth with 192 home runs...Under first-year manager Bud Black, the pitching staff posted a 4.51 ERA. The Rockies had two eleven-game winners (German Marquez, Kyle Freeland) and two ten-game winners (Antonio Senzatela, Jon Gray). Marquez led the staff in strikeouts (147). Closer Greg Holland ended the year tied for second in the majors in saves. He whiffed 70 opposing hitters...Colorado finished THIRD in the NL West but qualified for the second Wild Card spot in the post-season. They lost the Wild Card contest to Arizona at Chase Field, 11-8, in a game in which they never led.
