Second baseman Brian Dozier was "Mr. Everything" for the Twins as he led the ball club in homers (34), RBI (93), base hits (167), and runs scored (106). Miguel Sano (77 RBI) followed with 28 dingers while Eddie Rosario popped 27 home runs and was second with 78 RBI. Super-utilityman Eduardo Escobar added 21 round-trippers and 73 RBI. As a team, the Twins were fourth in the A.L. in batting (.260) and ninth in homers (206)...Ervin Santana showed why he was the ace of the pitching corps with a 16-8 win/loss record, 167 strikeouts, five complete games, and three shutouts. Flame-throwing Jose Berrios may be a future ace after he turned in a 14-8 record and 139 K's. Kyle Gibson won twelve ballgames. The staff was ninth in the league with a 4.59 ERA...Minnesota became the first team in major league history to make the post-season after losing 100 games the year before. They found themselves the second A.L. Wild Card but lost that game to the Yankees in New York, 8-4.
