As a ball club, the Red Sox hit .258 (eighth in the A.L.) and the fewest homers (168). The pitching staff finished the year second in the league with a smart 3.70 ERA...Chris Sale struck out 308 batters and allowed only 165 hits to post his 17-8 won/loss record. Fellow southpaw Drew Pomeranz won seventeen games as well (with six losses) and whiffed 174 opponents. After winning the Cy Young Award in 2016, Rick Porcello wasn't nearly as good with an 11-17 record and 181 strikeouts. He gave up the most home runs in the A.L. (38) when compared to just twenty-three the year before when he was 22-4 for the season. David Price had two stints on the disabled list with a sore pitching elbow and started his second return to action working out of the bullpen. He and broadcaster/Hall of Famer Dennis Eckersley also got into a sharp-tongued verbal altercation on a team airplane... "Mookie" Betts had an MVP-type season after leading the ball club in homers (24), RBI (102), base hits (166), runs scored (101), and doubles (46). Betts, Jackie Bradley, Jr., and youngster Andrew Benintendi provided the Bosox one of the best outfield trios in the league with their hitting and defense. Bradley hit 17 dingers while the 22-year-old Benintendi slugged 20 round-trippers and drove in ninety. DH Hanley Ramirez added 23 home runs; first baseman Mitch Moreland was good for twenty-two... The Red Sox outdistanced the Yankees by two games in the AL East with the Yanks taking their season series, 11-8... A great Houston team, on its way to a World Championship, knocked off Boston in the ALDS, 3-1. It cost skipper John Farrell his job after five years in the dugout. He won 586 games in the regular season and twelve in the post-season with one World Championship as manager (2013).
