**The Royals finished sixth in the American League in hitting (.259) and eleventh in home runs (193). Mike Moustakas enjoyed a great come-back season in leading the team with 38 homers. He drove in 85 runs. Eric Hosmer had a MVP-type year with 25 homers and the Royals high in RBI (94), base hits (192), and runs scored (98). Backstop Salvador Perez blasted 27 round-trippers to go with 80 RBI while DH Brandon Moss added 22 dingers for the year... Southpaw Jason Vargas, by far, topped the pitching staff with 18 victories. He struck out 134 batters. Both Danny Duffy and Jakob Junis won nine ball games. Jason Hammel, an eight-game winner, led the staff with 145 K's. Their conglomerate ERA of 4.61 placed them tenth in the A.L...K. C. missed the post-season for the second straight year and never held first place in the AL Central the entire campaign. At the most, they would reach only seven games above .500 at any point in the season (July 30<sup>th</sup>) and would fall as many as 22-games behind the division leader.**
