The Padres hovered between third and fourth place for most of the season. They had a winning record half-way through the year at 42-39 which placed them third in the NL West nine games out of first. At season's end, they were eighth in the N.L. with a .247 batting average but eleventh in home runs after hitting only sixty-four. Dave Winfield led the Padres' hitters with 13 home runs, 26 doubles, 139 base hits, and 81 runs scored. Mike Ivie finished the year as the team leader in RBI with 70--just one more than Winfield. Doug Rader was second on the ball club with nine dingers. He drove in fifty-five...Ace Randy Jones was the pitching staff's top winner with twenty-two, 25 complete games, and five shutouts. Brent Strom (12 wins) had the team high in strikeouts with a meager one-hundred three. Jones, with only 93 strikeouts for the season, was named the N.L. Cy Young Award recipient. Reliever/closer "Butch" Metzger was co-National League Rookie of the Year with Cincy's Pat Zachry. Metzger went 11-4 and struck out 89 batters in his "swing" role on the staff. Dave Freisleben won ten ball games. Padres' pitchers finished ninth in the league with a 3.65 ERA. They ended the year second after pitching 47 complete games.
