Bobby Bonds would lead the team with 10 homers and 54 RBI. (You read that right.) Jerry Remy had the team high in hits (132) and runs scored (64)... Frank Tanana won 19 games and completed 23 to lead the pitching staff. He racked up 261 strikeouts. Nolan Ryan (17-18) was tops on the staff with 327 K's and seven shutouts. "The Ryan Express" allowed 183 bases on balls and completed 21 games. The Angels' posted a major league leading 64 complete games. The staff led the American League with 992 K's and were fifth in ERA (3.36). As a team, they were LAST in the A.L. in batting average (.235) and home runs (63). The Angels ended the year sixth in the league with 126 stolen bases...They finished 14 games behind AL West Champion Kansas City from whom California won eight of eighteen games during the regular season...Managers' records: Williams (39-57), Sherry (37-29). Norm Sherry took command, July 24th, resulting in a doubleheader sweep of the Texas Rangers at "The Big A" in Anaheim.

Nolan Ryan struck out 18 White Sox batters in a game at Chicago, September 10th.
