Dave Winfield was the Padres' leader in homers (25), RBI (92), base hits (169), and runs scored (104). George Hendrick was next with 23 dingers and 81 runs batted in. Gene Tenace, picked up from Oakland in the off-season, added 15 home runs and 61 RBI. He led the majors in bases on balls (125). Gene Richards and Bill Almon tied for the team lead in triples (11). For the season, the ball club hit .249 and 120 homers...Southpaw Bob Shirley was the pitching staff's top winner (12) and leader in strikeouts (146). He walked 100 batters. Bob Owchinko won nine games while former Oakland closer "Rollie" Fingers won eight out of the bullpen, led the majors in saves, and made the most relief appearances (78). The staff ERA was 4.43...The Padres WON three season series: 10-8 against Houston, 7-5 versus Montreal, and 8-4 over St. Louis. They split twelve games with the Mets...Managers' records: McNamara (20-28), Skinner (1-0), Dark (48-65)...Future Hall of Famer Ozzie Smith was drafted in the fourth round of the major league amateur draft.
