Tom Seaver was acquired from the Mets, June 15<sup>th</sup>, for four players including Pat Zachry and Doug Flynn. Seaver and Fred Norman both led the pitching staff with 14 wins. Norman was the staff leader in strikeouts (160) while Seaver completed 14 games with four shutouts after joining the Reds. He punched out 124 batters. The staff posted a 4.21 ERA...National League MVP George Foster's 52 homers and 149 RBI placed him ahead of all major leaguers. He was the Reds high-man with 124 runs scored. Johnny Bench was next with 31 home runs and 109 RBI. Joe Morgan scored 113 runs and slugged 22 dingers. Dan Driessen added 91 runs batted in while Pete Rose was tops on the ball club with 204 base hits. The Redlegs were second in the N.L. with a .274 batting average and 802 runs scored. They were third with 181 home runs for the season...The season series with the arch-rival Dodgers ended in the Reds favor, 10-8, but L. A. won the NL West by ten games.
