The Tribe ended the '68 season with a team batting average of .234 and 75 home runs. Tony Horton led the ball club with fourteen homers and 59 runs batted in. Utilityman "Duke" Sims was next with eleven dingers and 44 RBI. Jose Cardenal knocked in 44 runs as well and led the Indians in hits (150) and runs scored (78)...Luis Tiant had the best record on the pitching staff at 21-9 and led the hurlers with 19 complete games and nine shutouts. "El Tiante" struck out 264 batters. Lefty Sam McDowell topped the staff with 283 K's while posting a 15-14 W/L record. McDowell also walked 110 batters and allowed 181 hits. Stan Williams won thirteen contests while "Sonny" Siebert was a 12-game winner. The Tribe's pitchers led the A.L. in ERA (2.66) and shutouts (20). They tallied 48 complete games (4th).
