Managers' records: Stanky (34-45), Moss (12-24), Lopez (21-26). Moss assumed managerial duties, July 12th; Lopez, on his second tour with the Chisox, became manager August 14th...Chicago played in 74 one-run games, an all-time A. L. record. They won 30 and lost 44. That number of losses is a major league record...Pete Ward topped this disaster of a ball club with 15 homers. He tied Tommy Davis for the lead in RBI (50). "Little Louie" Aparicio was the leader in base hits (164) and runs scored (55). The Sox finished sixth in the league with a .228 batting average and LAST with 71 home runs and 463 runs scored...The pitching staff ended the year fourth in the A. L. in ERA (2.75). Joe Horlen's twelve wins were the most among the hurlers. Tommy John won ten games and posted the most strikeouts (117). Gary Peters whiffed one hundred ten. The staff's 40 saves topped the league.
