Jose Abreu was the leader of the White Sox with 30 home runs, 101 RBI, and 178 hits. He also scored 88 times. Adam Eaton popped 14 dingers and led the team with 98 runs scored. Melky Cabrera, with 12 homers, was second to Abreu with 77 runs batted in. Avisail Garcia added 13 home runs. For the year, Chicago hit .250 but were LAST in the A.L. in home runs (136) and runs scored (622)...Ace Chris Sale led the pitching staff with his thirteen victories and the league with 274 strikeouts. Jeff Samardzija was 11-13 and struck out 163 batters. Jose Quintana finished second to Sale with 177 K's and ended the season with a 9-10 W/L record. Youngster Carlos Rodon showed flashes of a lot of good things to come: 9-6 record, 139 K's. Closer David Robertson had 86 strikeout victims and finished 53 games. White Sox hurlers turned in a respectable 3.98 ERA...Sox GM Rich Hahn aggressively set out to bring higher caliber personnel to the ball club after 2014 ended in disappointment as high expectations never panned out. Off-season acquisitions in starter Samardzija (a former Cub) and closer Robertson from the Yankees weren't enough to turn things around. Hahn picked up Cabrera to boost the offense and to compliment slugger Abreu, but Chicago still finished 19 games behind AL Central champ Kansas City...Chris Sale had 11.818 strikeouts per nine innings.
