The Bucs finished second behind the Cardinals in the NL Central and qualified for the post-season for the third straight year...A season in which many felt the Buccos would advance deep into the playoffs, ended in great disappointment when the Cubs eliminated the Pirates in the Wild Card game...Pedro Alvarez led the ball club with 27 homers; he drove in seventy-seven. Andrew McCutchen clubbed 23 dingers and led the team with 96 RBI and 91 runs scored. Starling Marte hit 19 homers and knocked in 81 runs. The Pirates hit 260 and 140 homers for the year...Gerrit Cole was the top winner on the pitching staff (19) and struck out 202 batters. Francisco Liriano was 12-9 and led the staff with 205 strikeouts. Jeff Locke ended the year 8-11 and struck out 129 batters. The staff ERA was second in the N.L. (3.21). They gave up the fewest homers in the majors (110).
