On August 14th, prior to a series against the Mariners at Fenway Park, MGR John Farrell shocked Red Sox Nation with the announcement he would have to leave the team for the remainder of the season to receive cancer treatments. Farrell's bench coach, Torey Lovullo, moved to the top step of the dugout and guided the Bosox to a 28-20 record for the rest of the schedule as "interim manager."...DH David Ortiz led the Red Sox with 37 homers and 108 RBI. One of those home runs made "Big Papi" the 27th player to hit 500 career homers in major league history. Xander Bogaerts followed with 81 runs batted in and a team high 196 base hits while Hanley Ramirez was second to Ortiz after clubbing 19 dingers. "Mookie" Betts added eighteen and topped the Bosox in runs scored (92)...The pitching staff's top winner was lefty Wade Miley who won eleven games and struck out 137 batters. Rick Porcello won nine games and led the staff with 149 K's. Joe Kelly and Eduardo Rodriguez both were ten-game winners. The staff posted an ERA of 4.31...The Boston's hit .265 for the season and 161 home runs...The Red Sox finished LAST in the A.L. East for the third time in four years, 15 games behind division champion Toronto. The record for the season series with the Blue Jays favored the Red Sox, 10-9.
