With rookie manager and Hall of Famer Paul Molitor directing proceedings from the dugout, the Twins posted their best overall record since 2010 and finished second to the eventual World Champion K. C. Royals by twelve games. The Twins were actually eliminated from playoff hopes in their second-to-last game of the year, a 5-1 loss at home to the same Royals...The ball club hit .247 and 156 homers for the year. Brian Dozier hit 28 home runs, drove in seventy-seven, and scored 101 times. Trevor Plouffe and Torii Hunter both hit 22 dingers; Plouffe led the team with 86 RBI. Joe Mauer led the ball club with 157 hits...Starters Kyle Gibson and Phil Hughes led the pitching staff after both won eleven contests. Gibson was the staff leader by racking up 145 strikeouts. Spot-starter Trevor May was 8-9 and struck out 110 batters. Twins' hurlers ended the year with a 4.07 ERA...Eddie Rosario set a Twins' rookie record and LED the American League with 15 triples.
