The Phillies and Expos closed down Connie Mack Stadium with a final game on October 1st. The Phillies won in the tenth inning when Oscar Gamble singled in Tim McCarver with two out. Many of the 31,000 spectators started to dismantle the ball park in earnest during the game; there was a mob on the field in search of souvenirs after the contest ended. Dick Selma was the last winning pitcher...The Phillies had planned to move into a new ballpark in South Philly for 1970, but construction delays pushed that back one year...On May 2nd, in a game at San Francisco, the Phils lost catchers Tim McCarver and Mike Ryan to broken hand injuries in the same inning. Bullpen coach "Doc" Edwards was activated to assist with catching duties in early June...Deron Johnson led the ball club with 27 homers, 93 RBI, and 147 base hits. Third baseman Don Money was next with 14 home runs and 66 RBI. Super utilityman Tony Taylor led the ball club in runs scored (74) and added nine homers, nine triples, and 55 RBI to the offense. For the year, the Phillies hit .238 and 101 homers...Rick Wise led the pitching staff with 13 wins. In his second tour with the Phils, Jim Bunning was the leader in strikeouts (147). Lefty Chris Short (9-16) topped the staff with seven complete games and struck out 133 batters. Selma, the team's closer, racked up 153 strikeouts. The staff was second in the National League with 1,047 strikeouts and finished the year seventh with a 4.17 ERA.
