The Tribe concluded the 70th season in franchise history 32 games behind AL East Champ, Baltimore, from whom Cleveland won only FOUR of eighteen regular season meetings...Graig Nettles led the ball club with 26 home runs and 81 runs scored while Vada Pinson (24 homers) was tops with 82 RBI, 164 base hits, and 28 doubles. Roy Foster added 23 homers while Ray Fosse slugged eighteen for the year. As a team, the Tribe hit 183 home runs and .249...Sam McDowell led the pitching staff with 20 victories, 304 strikeouts, 19 complete games, and 131 bases on balls. Steve Hargan won eleven, including eight complete games. Rich Hand was second with 110 K's. Dennis Higgins whiffed 82 batters. The staff ERA was 3.91 and led the A.L. with 1,076 strikeouts.
