The Cubs finished their 95th season in the National League and 55th at Wrigley Field only five games behind the NL East champ, Pirates. Chicago won eight of eighteen games against the Bucs during the regular season...The Cubbies had three big boppers in their line-up: Billy Williams (42 homers, 129 RBI); Jim Hickman (32 home runs, 115 RBI); and The Captain, Ron Santo (26 homers, 114 RBI). Johnny Callison added 19 homers and 68 runs batted in...Cubs' ace Ferguson Jenkins led the pitching staff in wins and strikeouts with 22 and 274, respectively. Bill Hands was an 18-game winner while Ken Holtzman won seventeen, and mid-season acquisition, Milt Pappas, won ten games. Jenkins completed 24 contests and finished third in Cy Young Award voting. As a staff, Cub pitchers led the National League with 59 complete games. The staff ERA was 3.76...At the plate, the Cubbies hit .259 and 179 homers.
