The Angels finished twelve games behind AL West Champ, Minnesota, and just three games in back of second place, Oakland...Team leaders: Jim Fregosi (22 home runs, 82 RBI, 95 runs scored) and Alex Johnson (14 homers, 86 RBI). Johnson was the American League batting champion and led the Angels in hits (202). Jim Spencer (12 home runs, 68 RBI); Ken McMullen (14 homers, 61 RBI); and Roger Repoz (18 home runs) were big offensive contributors as well. The Angels hit .251 and 114 home runs for the season...Clyde Wright's 22 wins led the pitching staff while Tom Murphy won 16 games and Rudy May (7-13) topped the hurlers with 164 strikeouts. Andy Messersmith added 11 victories and struck out 162 batters. The staff ERA was fifth in the league at 3.48...Jim Spencer (.995 fielding percentage) was awarded a Gold Glove as the best fielding first baseman in the American League.
