The Padres were no-hit by Dock Ellis of the Pirates in San Diego, June 12th. As the story goes, Ellis claims he pitched the game while under the influence of a mind altering substance. (Ellis's personal report was that he forgot he was scheduled to pitch the twelfth and did some acid the evening prior. He said he woke at 10 am on the day he was to pitch and forgot where he was at that moment.) Team leaders: Nate Colbert (38 home runs, 86 RBI); "Cito" Gaston (29 homers, 93 RBI) and Ollie Brown (23 dingers, 89 RBI). Gaston led the ball club in hits (186) and runs scored (92). The Padres hit .246 (10th in the N.L.) but finished the year third with 172 home runs. (San Diego Stadium WAS NOT an easy place to hit homers.)...Leading the pitching staff was Pat Dobson with a 14-15 record and 185 strikeouts. Clay Kirby and lefty Danny Coombs both won ten games. Kirby had 154 K's. Spot starter Dave Roberts won eight games. The staff ERA was 4.36...The Padres scored 681 runs and allowed 788.
