**Team leaders: Willie Stargell (31 homers, 85 RBI); Bob Robertson (27 home runs, 82 RBI) and Al Oliver (83 RBI). "The Great One," Roberto Clemente, compiled a "triple double" with 22 doubles, 10 triples, and 14 homers. He also was awarded his tenth of twelve career Gold Gloves. Matty Alou led the ball club in hits (201) and runs scored (97)...Spot starter Luke Walker led the pitching staff with 15 wins while Bob Veale topped the staff with 178 strikeouts...The Buccos played their last game at the venerable but deteriorating Forbes Field in June and opened the brand new Three Rivers Stadium on July 16<sup>th</sup>. On that date, the Pirates debuted new double knit "pull over" jerseys, with a beltless look for the pants, which many major league teams copied soon after...Dock Ellis no-hit the Padres in San Diego, June 12<sup>th</sup>, reportedly under the influence of an illegal drug...Cincinnati swept the Bucs in three games in the NLCS. Danny Murtaugh was named the AP's N.L. Manager of the Year...The Bucs led the N.L. with a .270 batting average and 70 triples. They hit 130 home runs...Bucco pitchers were third in the league with a 3.70 ERA.**
