The Braves franchise ended its 100<sup>th</sup> season with a 26-game finish behind NL West Champion, Cincinnati. Atlanta won five of the eighteen meetings with the Redlegs during the regular season...Team leaders: Hank Aaron (38 homers, 118 RBI, 103 runs); Orlando Cepeda (34 home runs, 111 RBI); Rico Carty--the major league batting champ--25 homers and 101 RBI. Carty had 175 base hits and scored 84 runs. Felix Millan led the ball club with 183 hits. He scored 100 times...Pat Jarvis led the pitching staff with 16 wins, 173 strikeouts and eleven complete games. Jim Nash (13), Phil Niekro (12), and George Stone (11) were other starters posting double-figures in victories. The Braves led the N.L. in hitting with a .270 team average. They were fifth in the league with a total of 160 home runs...The staff ERA was ninth at 4.33.
