Manager Eddie Kasko was promoted from Boston's Triple A farm club and guided the Bosox to a finish within 21 games of the eventual World Champion Orioles. The Boston's won only five of eighteen games versus Baltimore during the regular season...Carl Yastrzemski led the Red Sox and the American League in batting average; he also topped the Bosox with 40 home runs, 186 hits and 125 runs scored. Tony Conigliaro had a terrific season and seemed well recovered after a horrible beaming in 1967: "Tony C." launched 36 homers, scored 89 times, and led the Red Sox with 116 RBI. Rico Petrocelli contributed 29 home runs and 103 runs batted in. "Yaz" drove home 102 runs. Mike Andrews hit 17 dingers and scored 91 runs. Reggie Smith added 22 homers and crossed the plate 109 times...Number one starter Ray Culp turned in a solid season and led the pitching staff with 17 wins and 197 strikeouts. Gary Peters was 16-11 with 155 K's; "Sonny" Siebert (142 K's) was a 15-game winner. Spot-starter Ken Brett whiffed a whopping 155 batters...The Red Sox led the A.L. with a .262 batting average and 203 home runs...The staff ERA was 3.87, eighth in the league.
