Third baseman Bill Melton led the Pale Hose in homers (33) and RBI (96). Luis Aparicio led the ball club in hits (173) and runs scored (86). Ed Herrmann was second with 19 dingers. The Sox hit .253 and 123 home runs...Tommy John topped the pitching staff with twelve wins, 138 strikeouts, ten complete games, and three shutouts. Gerry Janeski won ten games while closer Wilbur Wood went 9-13 in wins/losses. The staff ERA was 4.54, the WORST in the majors...This Sox ball club is considered one of the most hapless teams in major league history. Managers' records: Gutteridge (49-87), Adair (4-6), Tanner (3-13).
