Clyde King was fired as Giants' manager, May 23rd, with a record of 19-23. The organization's Triple A skipper, Charlie Fox, was promoted to the big league club and led the team to a 67-53 mark the rest of the season...The Giants' split their season series with both the Reds and Dodgers, 9-9...Willie McCovey led the ball club with 39 homers, 126 RBI, and 39 doubles. Catcher Dick Dietz posted a career season with 22 home runs, 107 RBI, 36 doubles and his first (and only) All Star Team selection. At 39-years-young, Willie Mays slammed 28 homers and drove in 83 runs. Twenty-four-year-old Bobby Bonds, with 200 base hits, put up a "triple double" with 36 doubles, 10 triples, and 26 home runs. He finished second in the majors with 134 runs scored...Gaylord Perry kept opposing batters off-balance with his so-called "spitter" and tied the Cards' Bob Gibson for the N.L. lead with 23 victories. Perry completed 23 games, including a league high five shutouts...Juan Marichal was 12-10 with 123 strikeouts and fourteen complete games...The Giants hit .262 for the season and 165 home runs. They scored the most runs in the N.L. (831). The staff ERA was 4.50 and third in the league with 50 complete games.
