Pedro Guerrero led the ball club with 32 homers and 103 runs batted in. He has quickly become one of the most feared hitters in the National League. New first baseman Greg Brock produced a solid season as he hit 20 home runs and drove in sixty-six. The '82 Rookie of the Year, Steve Sax, improved on his freshman campaign scoring 94 runs and increasing his stolen base total by seven sacks. Excellent centerfielder Kenny Landreaux (66 RBI) popped 17 dingers while his outfield mate, Mike Marshall, swung a potent stick by hitting 17 homers and driving home sixty-five. Dodger batters hit .250 for the year, were first in the N.L. with 146 home runs, and stole 166 bases (3rd)...Fernando Valenzuela once again led the pitching staff with 189 K's, nine complete games, and four shutouts. Starter Bob Welch equaled Valenzuela's victory total (15) and racked up 156 strikeouts. Jerry Reuss and Alejandro Pena both won twelve games. The Dodger staff was the league leader with a 3.10 ERA and gave up the fewest runs (609), tying them with Texas for the major league lead...The Phillies "Wheeze Kids" surprised the Dodgers in the NLCS with a three games to one series victory. L. A. had manhandled the Phils during the regular season, winning eleven games to the Phillies one...Future Dodger great Orel Hershisier made his major league debut in September...Nothing new here: Chavez Ravine hosted 3.5 million fans at Dodger Stadium for first place in attendance. Opened in 1962, it is STILL part of one of the most spectacular settings in all of baseball..."Candy" Maldonado's birth name is Candido.
