Nino Escalera has the distinction of being the first black ballplayer to wear a Redlegs uniform. The native of Puerto Rico singled as a pinch hitter in his first major league game against the Braves in Milwaukee, April 17th. Originally signed by the Yankees, '54 was Nino's only big league season. He played in seventy-three games, mostly as a pinch hitter.

Team leaders: Ted Kluszewski (49 homers, 141 RBI); Jim Greengrass (27 home runs, 95 RBI); Gus Bell (17 homers, 101 RBI).
Kluszewski led the major leagues in home runs and runs batted in. He scored 104 runs and finished second in National League MVP voting. Three pitchers posted 12 wins: Fowler, Valentine, and Nuxhall. Art Fowler led the staff in strikeouts with 93 K's...As a team, the Redlegs hit 147 homers and .262 for the season. The pitching staff had an ERA of 4.50...This ball club finished 23 games behind the pennant-winning New York Giants and won seven of the twenty-two games versus "Lippy" Durocher's World Champions.
