Tommy Holmes led the Braves and the entire National League with 28 homers, 47 doubles, and 224 hits. His 117 runs batted in was the best on the ball club. Chuck Workman wasn't far behind after hitting 25 home runs and driving in eighty-seven. Solid back stop Phil Masi stroked 25 doubles. The Braves hit .267 and were second in the N.L. with 101 homers...Jim Tobin's nine wins led the pitching staff. Johnny Hutchings was 7-6 and topped the staff with 99 K's. Ed Wright was second on the team with eight victories. The staff ERA was 4.04...Managers' records: Coleman (42-51), Bissonette (25-34). Bissonette assumed managerial duties, July 31st.
