Frank Robinson led the Redlegs with 31 home runs, 90 runs scored, and 83 runs batted in. Jerry Lynch was second after hitting 16 dingers and driving in 68 runs for the season. Catcher Ed Bailey (59 RBI) and Pete Whisenant (40 RBI) both hit eleven home runs. Gus Bell hit ten homers while Johnny Temple led the team in hits (166). The ball club hit .258 and 123 homers. They were second in the N.L. with 242 doubles...Knuckleballer Bob Purkey led the pitching staff with a 17-11 record, 17 complete games, and three shutouts. He had 70 strikeouts. Joe Nuxhall was 12-11 and topped the staff with 111 K's. Harvey Haddix (110 strikeouts) and Brooks Lawrence both won eight contests. The staff was third in the N.L. in ERA (3.73) and complete games (50). They allowed the fewest bases on balls (419)...The Redlegs were 52-61 with "Birdie" Tebbetts at the helm. In August, he was replaced by one of his coaches, Jimmy Dykes, who guided the ball club to a 24-17 record...Cincinnati ended the year 16 games behind N.L. champ, Milwaukee, who won the season series, 17-5.
