The Cubbies had co-leaders in homers for the season: Ron Cey and Jody Davis both with twenty-four. The former topped the ball club in RBI (90). Ryne Sandberg was the leader in runs scored (94) while Bill Buckner's 175 base hits were the most on the team. Sandberg posted 165 safeties. The Cubs hit .261 and 140 home runs for the year... Chuck Rainey led the pitching staff with fourteen wins. Dick Ruthven won twelve and completed five games which included two shutouts. Reliever Bill Campbell posted the most strikeouts (97). The staff ERA was 4.08, twelfth in the N.L...Mid-way through the season, the Cubs were 39-42 placing them fourth in the NL East just three games out of first. They slipped to fifth place for good three days later on July 12th and would get no closer than four-and-a-half games of the division leader, July 22nd...Managers' records: Elia (54-69), Fox (17-22). Charlie Fox was named skipper, August 22nd.
