The Tribe was hovering around the .500 mark until the calendar turned to June. In that month, the Indians were 11-0 at home and 11-6 on the road to boost them to the top of the AL Central. Cleveland won 14 straight games from June 17th through July 1st. At the end of June, they led second place K.C. by two games. The Tribe won the division by eight games over Detroit...Cleveland swept Boston in the ALDS, 3-0; and then eliminated Toronto in the ALCS in five games. The Indians went up a commanding three games to one in the World Series against the Cubs, but Chicago took the last three games by scores of 3-2, 9-3, and 8-7 in ten innings (the last two games in Cleveland) to take the crown...Mike Napoli and Carlos Santana each hit 34 homers to lead the ball club. Napoli was the leader with 101 RBI; right behind was Santana with 87 runs batted in. Jason Kipnis hit 23 home runs and drove in eighty-two. Shortstop Francisco Lindor had a team high 182 base hits and 99 runs scored...Ace Corey Kluber led the pitching staff with 18 wins and 227 K's. Josh Tomlin won thirteen games; Trevor Bauer (168 K's) was a twelve-game winner...Skipper Terry Francona was named the American League's Manager of the Year...The staff ERA was second in the league at 3.84 and led the A.L. with 1,398 strikeouts...The Tribe hit .262 and 185 home runs. They were first in the league after stealing 134 bases and second with 308 doubles.
