The end of the season for the Yanks found them nine games behind AL East Champ Boston (from whom the Yankees won eight of nineteen games) and just five games out of a Wild Card spot...Carlos Beltran hit 22 homers to lead the Yankees for the season before his trade to Texas...Middle infielders Starlin Castro and Didi Gregorius tied for the club lead in RBI (70). Castro, Gregorius, Brian McCann, and rookie Gary Sanchez each clubbed at least twenty home runs as well. Castro had a team high 156 base hits. Brett Gardner led the Yanks in runs scored (80). Sanchez won the starting catching job for the immediate future from McCann late in the season...Masahiro Tanaka topped the pitching staff with fourteen wins while Michael Pineda was the leader with 207 K's. Dellin Betances whiffed 126 batters...Mark Teixeira and Alex Rodriguez saw their Yankee careers come to an end. "Tex" had previously announced he planned to retire; "A-Rod" was released from his Yankee contract at season's end...For the year, the Yanks hit .252 and 183 home runs...The staff ERA was 4.16. They allowed the fewest bases on balls in the A.L. (444).
