New manager "Dusty" Baker returned the Nats to the top of the NL East, but the Dodgers knocked Washington out of the post-season after winning the NLDS, three games to two. The Nationals had won only one of six games between the two during the regular season...New addition Daniel Murphy led the ball club with 25 homers, 104 RBI, 184 base hits, and 47 doubles. He crossed the plate 88 times. Anthony Rendon was named the National League's Comeback Player of the Year following a season during which he socked 20 homers, drove home 85 runs, and scored a team high ninety-one. Danny Espinosa and Bryce Harper each posted 24 home run seasons...N.L. Cy Young Award winner Max Scherzer topped the pitching staff with a 20-7 record and 284 strikeouts. Tanner Roark won sixteen games while Stephen Strasburg was a fifteen game winner. "Stras" rang up 183 K's. The staff was second in the league in three categories: ERA (3.51), strikeouts (1,476), and fewest runs allowed (612)...As a ball club, the Nationals hit .256 and were fourth in the N.L. with 203 home runs.
