Rod Carew won his fourth American League batting title in '74--among his major league leading 218 hits were a team record 180 singles. He also had a team high 86 runs scored...Bobby Darwin led the ball club with 25 home runs and 94 RBI. He struck out 127 times. Larry Hisle followed with 19 dingers and 79 runs batted in. Harmon Killebrew (54 RBI) popped 13 home runs while DH Tony Oliva hit 13 dingers, as well, and drove home 57 runs. The Twins led the American League with a .272 batting average and 1,530 base hits. They clubbed 111 home runs...Bert Blyleven led the pitching staff with 17 victories, 249 strikeouts, and 19 complete games. Joe Decker was a 16-game winner, whiffed 158 batters, and completed eleven contests. Dave Goltz was an even 10-10 for the season. The staff ERA was 3.64 and led the A.L. in saves (29)...

Minnesota finished just eight games behind Oakland in the AL West. They were 5-13 versus the A's during the regular season...The Twins drew a tad over 662,000 fans to Metropolitan Stadium--last in the league and about HALF of what the team used to draw when the ball club enjoyed much success in the 1960s.
