Dick Allen and his 40 oz. bat led the White Sox with 32 homers. He had a team high 84 runs scored and finished second with 88 RBI for the year. Ken Henderson topped the ball club with 95 runs batted in and 176 hits. He popped 20 home runs. Bill Melton was second on the team after hitting 21 dingers; he added 63 RBI. Chicago hit .268 for the season to go with a league leading 135 home runs...Wilbur Wood had his famed knuckleball dancing and floating throughout the year in leading the pitching staff with 169 strikeouts and 22 complete games. Wood won twenty. Fellow starter Jim Kaat was the staff's top winner at 21-13 which included 15 complete games, a team high three shutouts, and his thirteenth straight Gold Glove Award. Closer Terry Forster struck out 105 batters. White Sox hurlers posted a 3.94 ERA and tied the Twins for first in the A.L. with 29 saves.

From 1971 through 1975 the White Sox wore red pin-striped uniforms with red caps. (This ensemble would reappear once again for Sunday home games in 2012.)

Chicago finished only nine games out of first place but the World Champion A's won the season series, 11-7.
