**Bob "Beetles" Bailey led the ball club with 20 home runs and 73 RBI. Willie Davis added 12 homers and drove home 89 runs to go with 27 doubles, 180 base hits, and 86 runs scored to top the Expos. Ken Singleton had 74 RBI...Steve Rogers and Mike Torrez each won 15 games. Rogers led the pitching staff with 154 strikeouts and eleven complete games...Les Expos finished just 8 ½ games behind division winning Pittsburgh; the two NL East rivals split the season series, 9-9...Montreal batters hit 86 home runs and for a .254 average. They were fourth in the league with 124 stolen bases. The hurlers pitched to a 3.60 ERA and compiled 27 saves--the latter a tie with the Reds for the top spot in the senior circuit. Attendance at Parc Jarry was a tad under 1.02 million..."Kid," Gary Carter, made his big league debut, September 16<sup>th</sup>, going zero for four against the Mets.**
