Team leaders: Rick Monday (20 home runs, 58 RBI, 84 runs scored); Jerry Morales (15 homers, 82 RBI); Jose Cardenal (13 dingers, 72 RBI, 159 base hits). In 117 games, Billy Williams hit 16 home runs with 68 runs batted in...Rick Reuschel led the pitching staff with 13 victories and was second with 160 strikeouts. Bill Bonham (11-22 W/L record) led the staff with 191 K's. The staff ended the season with a 4.28 ERA placing them eleventh in the N.L...The Cubbies hit a composite .251 with 110 homers...Old New York Giant first baseman, "Whitey" Lockman, guided the Cubs to a 41-52 record from the top step of the dugout. He was replaced on the bench, July 25th, by Jim Marshall who posted a 25-44 mark. The team NEVER had a winning record in any month of the season...The Cubs finished 22 games behind the first place Pirates. The two rivals split their season series, 9-9. Chicago won only ONE season series, 8-4, over Atlanta, and were a combined 7-23 versus the Dodgers and Cardinals...The Cubs hosted 1.015 million fans at Wrigley Field.
